Townhome values continue to increase in the first half of 2022.

The market softened during the second half of the year with townhome values dropping slightly.

In 2022 the real estate market shifted, after really strong sales and price increases over the last few years. The number of townhome sales in the 2nd half of 2022 was down by 9%, while the average price per sq ft was down by 12%.

There were 206 townhomes sold in 2022 (an average of 17 sales per month, compared to the first 4 months of 2023, where there were 51 sales (an average of 13 sales per month).

There are currently 49 townhomes listed for sale, which is historically low. Based on 13 sales per month this represents less than a 4 month supply. While current buyer activity

is slower than usual, a well-priced unit usually has no problem selling. Of the 51 sales so far in 2023; 22 pended sale in 10 days or less.
